## HEARLD SUN ARTICLE

### *In Sport, a well red team has edge*

WEARING red gives such an advantage in sport that it may need to be regulated so matches are fair, scientists say.

Anthropologists at the University of Durham England looked at the outcome of contests in the four disciplines in the 2004 Olympic games - tae Kwan do, Greco wrestling and freestyle wrestling - where competitors were given red or blue outfits.

Contestants wearing red won 56 per cent of the match, compared with those wearing blue

The study by Russell Hill and Robert Barton took a peek at the Euro 2004 football tournament, in which teams wore shirts of different colours to different matches.

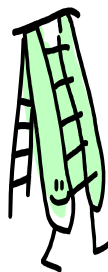
Teams scored more goals and had more wins when they played in red.

In sport if strength and skill are equal, wearing red presumably tips the balance between loosing and winning the study says.
