A big thankyou to David Tregartha for his help with the juniors while Glen Cock has been unavailable.

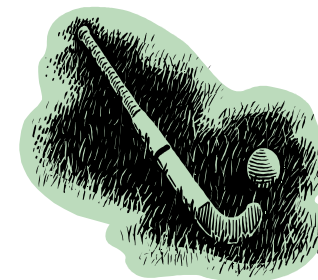
Also a big thankyou to all our hockey chockey sellers, especially the junior. The club made around \$700 from the chocolate sales - WELL DONE!
