

A special thanks to Ricky Barrett who gave his time every Thursday night to take on the role of training coach for the under 15s and provide valuable assistance to Glen and Jill.

As I stated earlier City Marians fielded 11 teams this season making it the largest hockey club in the northwest it has in excess of 120 playing members, and as a non-profit club its aim has been to keep membership affordable to the many families and individuals that make up this great club. You, the player, enjoy low subscriptions and this has been achieved by our fundraising activities, barbeques, wine sales, chocolate sales, raffles, trivia nights, vote count night and firewood sales.

Did you know that turf training costs the club \$170.00 per week, your weekly contribution of \$6.00 a game just covers the cost of turf hire at \$72.00 per team. Team registration cost the club \$7,700 this season and we turn over approximately \$30,000.00 per year.

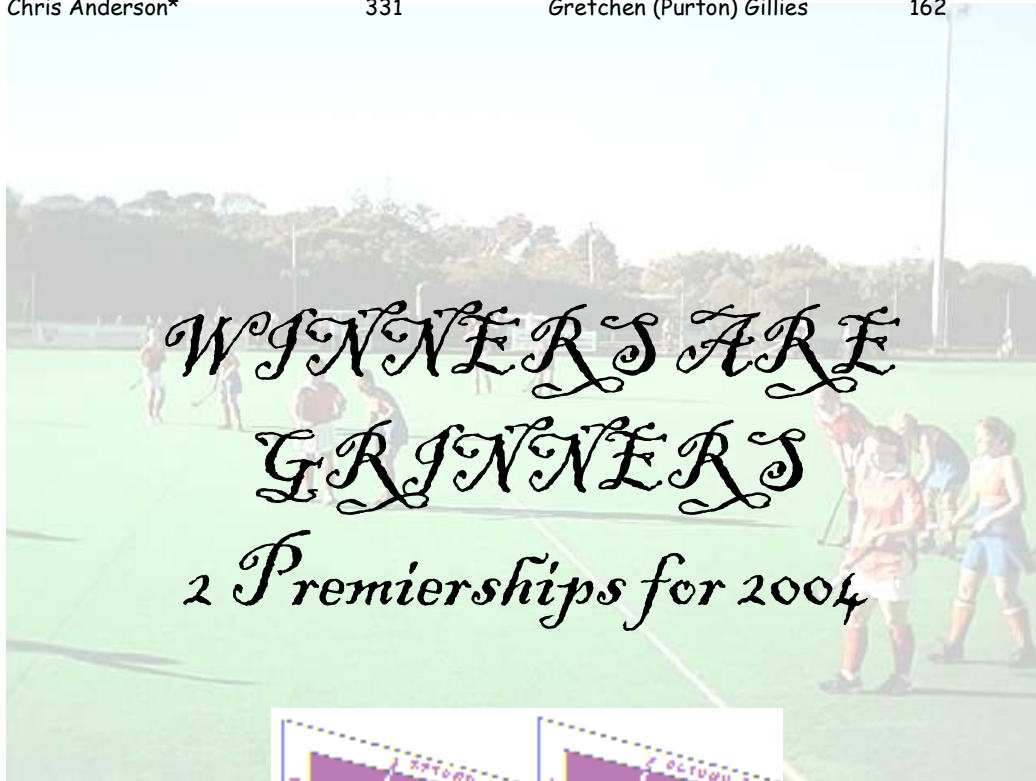
